Accepted Recycling Items*	
<p>Paper Items:</p> <p>Junk mail, paper bags, computer & writing paper</p> <p>Cardboard boxes (remove packing material and have them broken down)</p> <p>Milk, juice & ice cream cartons</p> <p>Facial tissue boxes, cereal, detergent, shoe boxes & other packaging containers</p>	<p>Plastic Items:</p> <p>Cups & containers #1 - #7</p> <p>Plastic bottles, jugs and jars (milk, peanut butter, soda, water, mustard, shampoo, mouthwash, medicine, lotion, detergent, bleach, etc.)</p> <p>Yogurt, cottage cheese, margarine & whipped topping containers</p> <p>“Clamshell” food containers (e.g.- produce, baked goods, etc.)</p>
<p>Glass Items:</p> <p>Bottles & jars containing a food or beverage when purchased</p> <p>Juice, soda, beer & wine bottles, etc.</p> <p>Baby food, mayonnaise, pickle & jelly jars, etc.</p>	<p>Metal Items:</p> <p>Metal cans containing a food or beverage when purchased</p> <p>Soda & beer cans; aluminum foil products</p> <p>Vegetable, soup, tuna, & pet food cans, etc.</p>

**Recycling items, except for cardboard boxes, must be in a blue or clear recycling bag that is tied.*

Accepted Trash Items	
<p>Junk mail, paper bags, computer & writing paper</p> <p>Cardboard boxes (remove packing material and have them broken down)</p> <p>Milk, juice & ice cream cartons</p> <p>Juice, soda, beer & wine bottles, etc.</p> <p>Baby food, mayonnaise, pickle & jelly jars, etc.</p> <p>Animal waste (must be double bagged)</p> <p>Diapers (must be double bagged)</p> <p>Food wrap, potato chip bags, metallic gift wrap</p> <p>Facial tissue boxes, cereal, detergent, shoe boxes & other packaging containers</p>	<p>Plastic bottles, jugs and jars (milk, peanut butter, soda, etc.)</p> <p>Yogurt, cottage cheese, margarine & whipped topping containers</p> <p>Food containers (e.g.- produce, baked goods, etc.)</p> <p>Metal cans containing a food or beverage when purchased</p> <p>Soda & beer cans; aluminum foil products</p> <p>Vegetable, soup, tuna, & pet food cans, etc.</p> <p>Styrofoam, plastic bags and plastic wrap</p> <p>Dishes, cups, light bulbs (not CFLs), pottery, pots and pans</p>

Non-Acceptable Trash and Recycling Items

Non-Acceptable Recycling Items	
Air-conditioning filters	Light bulbs, ceramics or window glass
Batteries	Motor-oil containers
Candy wrappers	Packing materials (styrofoam peanuts, bubble wrap)
Clothes hangers, scrap metal, automotive parts	Paper towels, napkins, tissues or paper plates
Clothing, cloth or rags	Plastic bags (any type)
Diapers	Potato chip bags
Dinnerware (glass or plastic)	Propane or oxygen tanks
Dog/cat food bags	PVC piping
Fast food items (food, wrappers, or greasy bags)	Rubber bands or elastic products
Gift wrap, shredded paper	Styrofoam (including egg cartons)
Hazardous waste	Trash
Inserts from paperboard boxes (plastic bags/trays)	Wood or yard waste
Photographs, hardback or paperback books	Blueprints, heat sensitive receipt paper

Non-Acceptable Trash Items	
Paint, pesticide or oven cleaner cans	Medical Waste (needles, syringes, bags, filters and tubes)
Computers and large electronics	Furniture
Window panes, mirrors, light bulbs	Wood or plastic crates
Windshields, car windows, treated glass, glass table tops, televisions	Large and small appliances
